#### Mathematics

#### English

- In English we are going to begin with fiction, reading the wonderful picture books "Incredible You" and "The Growing Story".
   We will respond with discussion, drama, presentations and writing, creating descriptive diary entries.
- In our non-fiction work we will revisit the four types of sentence, thinking of and writing questions for our visitors.
- Hedgehogs will also take part in regular Phonics, Handwriting, and Guided Reading lessons, learning our letters and sounds and embedding all of our key literacy skills.

### Topic Work

- Our Topic this term is all about wellbeing and so focuses on Science and PSHE. We will learn who the emergency services are and how they help us.
- As well as learning about our bodies, we will find out what we mean by good mental and emotional health, naming and describing different emotions and using the "5 Ways to Wellbeing".
