<p>Topic</p> <p>Knowledge: Consider what everyday life was like for Ancient Egyptians. Understand the process of mummification. Learn about the life of Cleopatra and why she is an important figure in Ancient Egypt. Study Egyptian Gods.</p> <p>Skills: Investigate Egyptian artefacts and consider what they tell us about Egyptian life and beliefs. Compare life in Ancient Egypt to modern day. Explore the mummification process.</p>	 <p>Spring 1 Owl Class 2025-26</p> <p>Pharaohs and Mummies</p>	<p>Science Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C). Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.</p>
