- Compare and contrast to recent history and if we think the same would happen in modern day

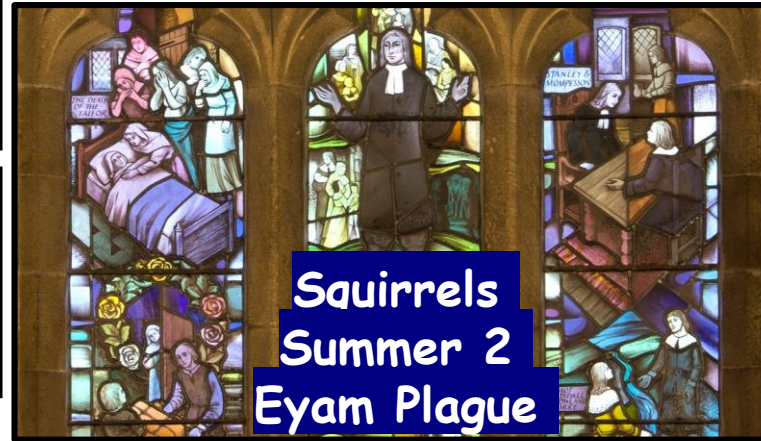
