Children enjoyed an online Egyptian British Museum experience as part of last half terms topic. Squirrel children said it was interesting to see the actual artefacts - such as the famous Rosetta Stone which helped archaeologists to interpret the hieroglyphic language.

PCSO Boswell visited school to talk about knife crime – the older children reported back that they'd learnt about the rules and the dangers. He talked about the consequences and they had also thought about saying no and asking for help: although this is a difficult topic it is so crucial that the children are prepared for life outside the village.

Thank you for joining us for the end of term worship – it was wonderful to see so many parents.

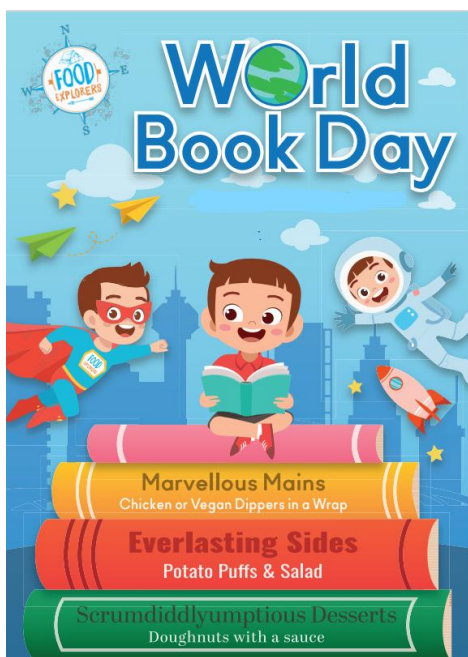
